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- NAXOS SOLVER is a C++ Constraint Programming library.
- It is freely available in the open source community together with its full documentation [3].
- It enforces a bounds-consistency variant in order to propagate changes that happen in Constraint Satisfaction Problem variables [1]. This happens in every single node of the search tree.
- It supports the definition of custom search methods via a declarative API [4].
- Declarativity is a NAXOS key feature and it has do with describing problems and search methods independently. NAXOS serves the Constraint Programming principle: *The user states the problem, the computer solves it* [2].
- NAXOS is being used in various applications, such as the construction of the timetable for the Department of Informatics and Telecommunications of the University of Athens every semester [5].
